Chief Appraiser Lisa Murphy and Office Manager Lisa McLachlan were also present.

2024-079. At 6:00 p.m. Chase Broussard opened the hearing.

2024-080. A quorum was established (5 of 7, then 6 of 7).

2024-081. <u>Public Access:</u> No one from the public was present to address the board with comments about the 2025 Budget or 2025-2026 Reappraisal Plan.

2024-082. Chief Appraiser, Lisa Murphy, reported that Clay County was the only taxing jurisdiction to disapprove the 2025 Budget. Wade Wesley, of Bellevue ISD, had contacted her with some questions, but was apparently satisfied with the answers provided.

2024-083. Motion to approve the 2025 Budget was made by Bobby Elledge, seconded by Oat Deweber, and passed 4-1-0 with the opposing vote coming from Chase Broussard of Clay County.

2024-084. Motion to approve the 2025/2026 Reappraisal Plan was made by Richard Harding, seconded by Matthew Shoemaker, and passed 6-0-0. Dee Ann Littlefield had arrived at 6:25 and participated in this second vote during the hearing.
